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Liposuction FAQs

⊘ What is Tumescent Liposuction?

Liposuction is a surgical technique that improves the body's contour by removing excess fat deposits located between the skin and muscle. Tumescent liposuction refers to a form of liposuction that uses tumescent local anesthesia. The tumescent technique for liposuction totally by local anesthesia has eliminated the greatest dangers associated with the older forms of liposuction. This makes the procedure relatively safe and risk free for the patients and ensures a better experience for them.

Am I A Good Candidate for Liposuction Surgery?

Ideal candidates for liposuction include:

- Adults within 30% of their ideal weight who have firm, elastic skin and good muscle tone
- Healthy Individuals who do not have life threatening diseases or medical conditions that can impair healing
- Individuals with a positive outlook and specific goals in mind for body contouring.

⊘ Which Body Areas can be treated by Liposuction?

The most frequently treated areas are the abdomen, breasts, hips, outer thighs, anterior thighs, inner thighs, knees, arms, buttocks, cheeks and neck.

✓ How does Liposuction Affect the Appearance of the Skin?

The appearance of skin after liposuction depends on the skin's elasticity. Skin with good elasticity should look smooth and natural after liposuction. Scars are not a common problem with modern liposuction which uses very small cannulas (microcannulas) and thus only very small incision are required

✓ Is there Pain or Discomfort after Liposuction Surgery?

During the two days immediately after liposuction, the amount of pain experienced depends on the type of anesthesia used for liposuction. Soreness is usually the most intense 2 to 4 days after liposuction and then decreases steadily. The tenderness and soreness typically is quite bothersome for up to 4 weeks, but gradually subsides over the following next 4 to 8 weeks.

Is the Fat Removal Permanent?

The fact is that the only way to remove stubborn fat is to physically take it out. The solution is thus instant and permanent as the removed fat cells are no longer present to increase in size. Not all fat can be removed from an area, as some fat is needed for body insulation to keep us warm in winter, for the final skin result and also to maintain overall body proportions. If a patient puts on excess weight after liposuction (usually 7 to 10kg or above) the residual fat cells may divide. The liposuction result will stay the same, i.e. the proportionality correction, but the body will put on weight all over. It is thus recommended that patients maintain their weight after the procedure within 7 to 10kg. And no, fat does not preferentially go onto other areas that were not treated.
